

## The Ultimate Local Experience: Trek & Tour

Duration – 8 Nights / 9 Days

Route: Leh → Likir to Hemis Shukpachen (Trek)  
→ Nubra Valley → Pangong Lake → Leh

Why choose between a trek and a vehicle tour? This perfectly balanced itinerary gives you 3 days of walking through ancient villages and living in traditional homestays, followed by an iconic drive to Ladakh's famous high-altitude valleys and blue lakes.

### Day 1: Acclimatization & Warm Welcomes

- **The Local Way:** No rushing today. We welcome you to Julley Ladakh Homestay in Leh with warm cups of butter tea. We spend the day relaxing and letting your body adapt to the high altitude.
- **Evening:** A gentle walk up to Shanti Stupa for a beautiful sunset over Leh town, followed by a stroll through the Leh Main Market.

- Stay: Julley Ladakh Homestay, Leh.

### Day 2: Trek Day 1 | Leh to Likir & Trek to Yangthang

- **Morning:** We drive you to the ancient Likir Monastery to begin your trek.
- **The Walk:** You will cross the Phobe La pass and walk through quiet, oasis-like hamlets.

- **The Local Way:** You will arrive in the peaceful village of Yangthang. Tonight, you will stay with a local family, eat a traditional dinner, and listen to stories by the kitchen fire.

- Stay: Traditional Village Homestay, Yangthang. (Walking time: 4-5 hours)

### Day 3: Trek Day 2 | Yangthang to Hemis Shukpachen

- **The Walk:** A beautiful, easy walk across the Tsermangchen La pass. As you descend, you will enter Hemis Shukpachen, widely considered one of the prettiest villages in Ladakh, famous for its sparkling streams and ancient juniper trees.

- **The Local Way:** Another night of pure immersion in a village home, surrounded by barley fields.

- Stay: Traditional Village Homestay, Hemis Shukpachen. (Walking time: 3-4 hours)

### Day 4: Trek Day 3 | Trek to Ang & Sightseeing Drive to Leh

- **The Morning Walk:** Wake up to the crisp mountain air. We take a short, beautiful walk down to the village of Ang, famous for its lush apricot orchards, where your trekking journey officially ends. (Walking time: 3 hours)

- **The Drive Back with a Twist:** Our vehicle will meet you in Ang. On the scenic drive back to Leh, we turn it into an unforgettable sightseeing adventure:

- **The Sangam:** We stop to see the shiny green waters of the Zaskar River merge into the mighty Indus.

- **Magnetic Hill:** We will park at a specific spot and let you watch the vehicle appear to roll uphill on its own!

- **Gurudwara Pathar Sahib:** We will stop at this highly sacred Sikh shrine built in 1517.

- **Hall of Fame:** Before entering Leh, we pay our respects at this inspiring museum honoring the brave soldiers who defended this region.

- Stay: Back to the comfort of Julley Ladakh Homestay in Leh!

### Day 5: Over Khardung La to Nubra Valley

- We leave early to drive up over the famous Khardung La pass (one of the highest motorable passes in the world) and descend into the breathtaking Nubra Valley. Enjoy a ride on the double-humped Bactrian camels at the Hunder sand dunes.

- Stay: Cozy local guesthouse/homestay in Nubra

### Day 6: Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso

- We follow the carving path of the Shyok River directly to the famous blue waters of Pangong Lake. We avoid the loud tourist camps and stay in the quiet, authentic village of Maan or Merak right on the edge of the lake.

- Stay: Authentic lakeside homestay at Pangong.

### Day 7: Sunrise at the Lake & Thiksey Monastery on the way back to Leh

- Wake up early to see the incredible morning colors over Pangong Lake. On the drive back to Leh via the massive Chong La pass, we will stop at the stunning, 12-story Thiksey Monastery to see the giant Maitreya Buddha statue.

- Stay: Julley Ladakh Homestay, Leh.

### Day 8: Old Leh & Last-Minute Shopping

- A relaxed day to explore the historic Leh Palace and do some shopping for authentic prayer flags, hand-woven Pashmina, and local dried apricots at the Leh Main Market without tourist markups.

- Stay: Julley Ladakh Homestay, Leh.

### Day 9: Julley & Farewell

Enjoy a final breakfast with our family before we drop you off at the airport with traditional white silk scarves (Khatags) and memories to last a lifetime.

### Important Trekking & Tour Notes:

**The Difficulty Level:** This specific trek is known as the "Baby Trek" of Ladakh. It has gentle ascents and is perfect for beginners and families! However, you are still walking above 3,500 meters, so a basic level of fitness is required.

### Luggage

You only need to carry a small daypack with your water and a jacket during the trek. We will safely transport your main luggage directly back to your room at Julley Ladakh Homestay so it is waiting for you when you return on Day 4!

### What is Included:

- Stays: 5 Nights in Leh (Julley Ladakh Homestay), 2 Nights in traditional village homestays during the trek, and 1 Night in Nubra and Pangong.
- Meals: Hearty, traditional Ladakhi breakfast and dinner every single day.
- Transport: A dedicated, private local SUV (Innova, Xylo, or Scorpio) with a skilled mountain driver for all tour and transit days.
- Trekking: A knowledgeable, friendly local village guide for your 3-day trek.
- Permits: We take care of all wildlife fees and Inner Line Permits (ILP) required for Nubra and Pangong!

### What is NOT Included:

- Flights to and from Leh.
- Daily lunch, beverages, and personal snacks.
- Monastery and museum entry tickets.
- Camel riding or any adventure activity fees in Nubra.
